# Q: What is the coverage of OWWA Project Care?

A: It shall cover distressed arriving and departing land based and sea based OFW-repatriates during the period of implementation of the Enhanced Community Quarantine.





A: Only distressed sea based and land based OFWs who are bound for their residences outside of the National Capital Region (NCR) will be qualified.



## Q: Who is considered an OFW in distress?

A: A distressed OFW may be broadly defined as one who has medical or psycho-social problems requiring treatment, hospitalization, and/or counseling; and/or problems like labor, immigration and other issues requiring legal representation.

### Q: What are the requirements to avail of this assistance?

#### A: Presentation of the following:

Proof of overseas employment

Copy of their passport or travel documents

Certification as OFW Repatriates from the OWWA Repatriation and Assistance Division (RAD)



### Q: What assistance will be provided for all affected OFW Repatriates?

Certificate of Eligibility to Project Care

Transportation Assistance

Temporary Shelter



# O: Who will shoulder the expenses for the temporary shelter of distressed OFWs?

Philippine Recruitment Agency for newly hired distressed landbased workers

Philippine Manning Agency for newly hired distressed seabased workers



Q: Can the distressed OFWs opt to directly book hotel accommodation on their own account?

A: Yes, provided that they request for a Certificate of Eligibility from OWWA-RAD.
